PART OF THIS EASEMENT FROM THE SLOUGH NORTHEASTERLY WAS ACQUIRED BY MR. COZINE IN BOOK 285 PAGE 294 LCDR AND RESERVED TO ASSIGNS ON R184/53115 LCDR. THE EASEMENT SOUTH OF THE SLOUGH TO HIGHWAY 58 WAS ACQUIRED BY THE STATE OF OREGON IN BOOK 230 PAGE 486 LCDR, ALSO, CSF# 11913 & 12445 SHOW A "RIGHT

NARRATIVE: THIS SURVEY WAS PERFORMED AT THE REQUEST OF DON COLTON FOR LOCATING THE BOUNDARY OF A PARCEL OF LAND DESCRIBED IN

THE CURRENT PARCEL IS IN THE NORTHERN PART OF THE MILTON RIGGS DLC# 57 SURVEYED IN 1855. IN 1869, CSF# 210 CREATED A PARCEL IN THE NE PART OF THE DLC. MONUMENTS WERE SET ON THE WEST LINE OF CSF#

LANDS IN THE NW OF THE DLC WERE DEEDED TO MR. KEENEY, THEN TO MR. ELLIS IN 1907, AND THEN TO MRS. VANOSDEL IN JUNE 1908 RECORDED IN BOOK 74 PAGE 624 LCDR. MRS. VANOSDEL HAD HER PROPERTY PARTITIONED ON CSF# 2154A; PART OF THAT BOUNDARY RAN FROM A 10" OAK AT (A) TO THE WEST LINE OF CSF# 210 AT (G) AND THEN ALONG THE WEST LINE OF CSF# 210, 17.15 CHAINS TO THE SW CORNER AT (H). THE SOUTHERN PARCEL WAS DEEDED TO MR. J. MILLER IN 1908, IN BOOK 76 PAGE 538 LCDR, AND THEN DEEDED TO GEORGE & LENA WASKE IN 1924 IN BOOK 140 (NOT 180)

THE REMAINDER OF MRS. VANOSDEL LAND NORTH OF THE PARTITION BOUNDARY WAS DEEDED IN 1909 TO MR. EAKIN IN BOOK 76 PAGE 596 LCDR. THE TITLE TO THESE LANDS TRANSFERRED TO MR. HILL AND THEN TO MR. BELL TO MR. A. MILLER AND THEN TO MR. LOWRY ET AL. IN 1933 IN BOOK 176 PAGE 410 LCDR. MR. LOWRY SURVEYED HIS LAND ON CSF# 6081 IN 1933 AND NOTED THE DISTANCE FROM (G) TO (B) AS 1137.67', CONFLICTING WITH THE ORIGINAL DEED CALL OF 17.62 CHAINS (1162.92').

IN 1950 LOWRY SOLD OFF A PARCEL, CONTAINING THE CURRENT PARCEL, TO COZINE IN BOOK 409 PAGE 546 LCDR WHICH DESCRIBED THE EAST BOUNDARY AS ALONG THE WESTERLY LINE OF CSF# 210 TO THE NE CORNER

WM. THOMSON SET AN IRON PIPE AT THE OAK AT (A) IN 1952 ON CSF# 8877. RALPH FOLLETT RESURVEYED THE ENTIRE WEST BOUNDARY OF CSF# 210 ON CSF# 21732, IN 1968 AND RECORDS THE DISTANCE AS 2295.6'. STEVE WOODS SURVEYED THE SAME LINE IN 2002 ON CSF# 37476, AND MEASURED

THE CONTROLLING CORNERS WERE: THE OAK AT (A) AND THE CORNERS OF THE WEST LINE OF CSF# 210 AT (B) & (H). HOLDING THE NW CORNER OF CSF# 210, I SET THE CORNER AT (E) AT THE DEED DISTANCE. HOLDING THE SW CORNER OF CSF# 210, I SET THE NE CORNER OF THE WASKE DEED AT (G) USING 17.15 CHAINS AS CALLED FOR IN THE DEED. I USED THE POINT AT (G) AND THE FOUND OAK AT (A) TO DETERMINE THE SOUTH BOUNDARY OF THE CURRENT PARCEL. THE WEST BOUNDARY IS THE EXISTING SLOUGH CENTERLINE, REFERENCED WITH MONUMENTS AT (D). THE NORTH BOUNDARY RUNS FROM (E) ON THE RECORD BEARING TO THE CENTERLINE OF THE SLOUGH. THE WEST LINE OF CSF# 210 DEFINES THE EAST BOUNDARY OF THE

THE BASIS OF BEARING FOR THIS SURVEY IS CSF# 37476. THE INSTRUMENT USED WAS A LEICA T1610 AND DI-1000 IN A TRAVERSE THROUGH ALL CONTROLLING CORNERS WITH A CLOSURE OF BETTER THAN 1:165,299. ALL MEASUREMENTS AGREE WITH RECORD OR DEED BEARING AND

THE CONFLICTED AREA CONTAINS TWO STRUCTURES AND MOBILE HOMES. DON COLTON HAS BEEN ADVISED TO RESOLVE THIS CONFLICTED AREA.
